



Everyone Can Get Health Care Here

Our goal is to provide you with quality care, even if you do not have insurance today. We do charge fees. But we will not turn you away if you cannot afford to pay.

Our Sliding Fee Scale

We may be able to lower the cost to you. You just need to show us your income. You also need to tell us your family size. We use this to see how much we can lower the cost.

You can show us your income by giving us a pay stub, your tax return, or other documents. We accept the types of proof on the back of this sheet.

We will only ask you for this once each year. But tell us if your income changes later. We may be able to lower your cost even more.

Also, tell us if you are homeless right now. We can lower the costs for you if you can show proof. We accept the types of proof on the back of this sheet.

We can also help you to sign up for TennCare or CoverKids if you qualify. If you sign up, you may not need to pay anything today. You may also be able to get your prescriptions. Ask us about this help.

Payment Plans

We will send you a bill for any amount you do not pay today. Call us at 615-227-3000 if you need to work out a payment plan.

Added Costs

You must pay the costs for some supplies. These include IUDs, Nexplanon, and some x-rays. Also, you must pay for the cost of dental labs, dentures, and partials. We cannot lower these costs.

We will talk with you about this before we use any of these supplies.

Types of Proof We Accept

We accept the following as **proof of household income**:

- Most recent tax return (or tax transcript)
- 1099 or W-2 forms
- Paycheck stub or other document from employer within the preceding three months (no notarization required)
- WIC approval letter
- SNAP/Food Stamps approval letter
- Unemployment benefits approval letter
- CoverRx approval letter
- Bank account statements showing direct deposits by Social Security and/or employer(s)
- Social Security Benefit Verification letter
- Eligibility notices from the federal marketplace (www.healthcare.gov)
- Eligibility notices from any state agency (e.g., TennCare, Department of Human Services, etc.) showing child in TennCare
- Statements about receiving public benefits
